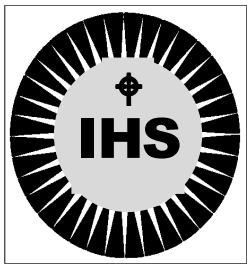

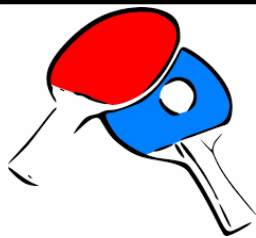

REFLECTION

Problems with First Reading – not really a re-enactment of Original Sin; not blaming women for Original Sin; but does point out that I find a way of going against God's Will, and I can influence in others doing the same, or not doing the same. I like snakes – many people don't. A beautiful Psalm – let us pray it slowly at Mass today. Paul writes of giving due value to the spiritual or invisible world – I hope I can explain this in the sermon.

The Gospel speaks of the Mother, brothers and sisters of Jesus, who points out that we are his family when we listen to his words and put them into practice. He speaks about the devil and how his influence is not divided, but united to multiply evil in our lives and through us. The devil can have no power over us so long as we trust in the Holy Spirit and let ourselves be guided in paths of holiness and not evil.

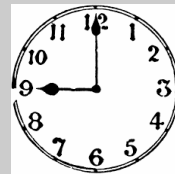
