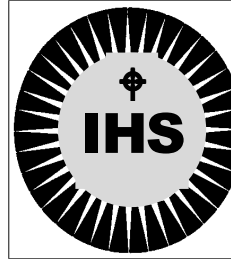

### REFLECTION

We are asked on this Sunday to value what we eat and drink, and for what it really serves in our lives. We have eternal life before we die, for 'everybody who believes has eternal life'. Faith will no longer exist in heaven, because we see the Father 'face to face' and know him. The eternal life is love since love is the only thing that will last to eternal life.

After the Fall, Adam and Eve were shut off from the tree of Life and we were all destined to die. But Jesus makes himself the Tree of Life, the fruit of this tree is the Eucharist, which is the body of Christ. Any one who believes and eats it has eternal life. The love with which we love Jesus now is the same love that we will have for him when he reveals himself to us on the day of our death, no matter how alone we feel or how much we suffer in darkness, we can take consolation that we already enjoy heaven. This is the only way that suffering can become, not only bearable, but a light and easy burden.

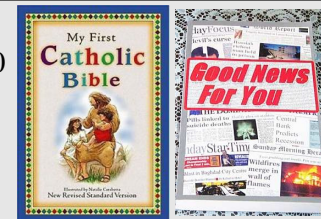
