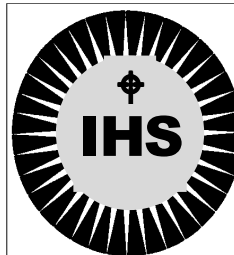

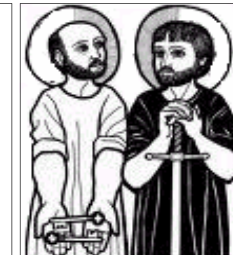

REFLECTION

Why does Jesus demand from his disciples that his identity as Christ be received in secret? Perhaps because the depths of what that means remain a mystery. Were we to speak too quickly about who he is then we risk diminishing the mystery, we risk reducing it down to our understanding. Jesus cannot stand that we reduce what he has come to reveal to a merely human way of understanding because ultimately this will reduce the love that people have for his Father. We see this when Jesus rebukes Peter. Peter has not received the revelation of Christ's identity with a contemplative silence, he speaks too soon, reduces the mystery and endangers the faith of the other disciples and so Jesus reacts out of a burning love that will not allow the truth to be diminished. We can be sure that whenever anyone endangers our faith Jesus will be as quick to leap to our defence.

Finance Committee Report

The Parish is responsible for a cemetery on SH1 just out of Warkworth. It is approximately 1.25ha on the left hand side of the road just past the showgrounds. There are two portions, a grazing paddock as well as cemetery and carpark. There is currently a sign there for Mitre 10. With the development of the Matakana Link Road and new Motorway a portion of this land is being compulsory acquired by the NZTA and a further portion is being leased for the duration of the construction. The funds from this are going to be deposited in an interest bearing account with the Diocesan Building Fund.

Auckland Council plans are for Warkworth to add another 20,000 people. This will likely mean we need a new parish centre as well the possibility of a primary and secondary school. The recommendation of the Finance Committee to the Diocese is that the grazing paddock be held onto for now and that it be eventually sold to help fund this development.
