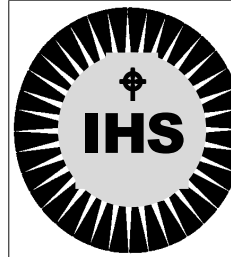

### REFLECTION

Ezekiel is sent as a prophet to those Israelites who are rebellious. Paul then points out to us and the Corinthians in the second reading that by glorifying in our infirmities we make space for the power of God to work. Then in the Gospel, Jesus, like other prophets is rejected by his own, foreshadowing the final rejection of his death. The fact that members of his community recognised that he was wise and could work miracles and yet would not accept him shows the attraction of truth can be hidden from us by old ideas that we are used to and that we hold on to. We must do everything that we can to purify our minds and hearts, to make ourselves poor of spirit or else we risk being blind to Jesus, who is the font of all new things; he longs to renew us each day. Are we ready to be poor and blind so we can receive everything he wants to give?

## PROLIFE FACTS

Parliament's Justice Committee received more than 35,000 written submissions on the End of Life Choice Bill. It is a record number received by any parliamentary committee on any issue and prompted



them to request an extension. They are now due to report back to Parliament by March 2019, which will be followed by a Second Reading debate and vote on the bill. Oral submissions have now started and will play an important role in the consultation process. Due to the huge number of written submissions, the Justice Committee MPs may only be able to read the submissions of people who are scheduled to speak to them. The other submissions will be read, but maybe only be administrative staff members. The MPs are the decision makers. If you would like your submission to have more impact, please make every effort to also speak to the MPs in person.
