Readers

The Lectionary stays on the lectern – it is not to be carried in the procession.

Please liaise with your partner and check that what you have prepared is the correct reading for the day and open in the lectionary.

Do ask for help with tricky words or phrases, rather than make a mistake.

Do not read out the short explanation or synopsis in the lectionary that is written in red, in italics. This is NOT part of the reading.

Please keep silence after each reading and before you say "the word of the Lord ", ((DO NOT SAY " " this is the word of the Lord")

Silence is also observed after the first reading and the psalm, for the time it takes to silently and quickly say a 'Glory be to the Father'.

The second reader must sit on a chair during the first reading, then join the first reader for the psalm.

First reader sits on a chair at the end of the psalm.

Prayers of the Faithful

There are written prayers available for every Sunday.

If you prefer to prepare your own "Prayers of the faithful" the format to observe:

- pray for the church
- for those in positions of authority
- salvation of the world
- for those in need in the community
- for the local needs of the parish.

They usually take the form of a series of short prayers (two or three succinct sentences).

4 or 5 prayers on paper and read them from the lectern.

Walk up to the lectern as the Creed is ending, or after the priest's introduction to the prayers of the faithful.

Stay in position until Father has finished the concluding prayer and everyone says "Amen".

Then walk off the altar, turn and bow, walk back to your place.

Set Up – Special Feasts and Traditions

Do please check the laminated sheets hanging in the sacristy to see if coloured vestments, banners, palms etc. are needed.

Remember

before Mass starts, all the special ministers for the mass, will gather with Father at the back, then process in order:

altar server with cross, readers, other special ministers, then Father. When the procession reaches the front, the cross bearer go straight on to the altar without kneeling or bowing.

Everyone else bows then Father walks to the altar, the everyone else return to their places.
